Rahan Comhaltas News: We do not have a lot of news in Rahan Comhaltas this week. Instead a little historical exercise took place compliments of Michael Lynam of Rahan Comhaltas who undertook to do a little project work and try and compile an outline of the first members of Rahan Comhaltas which was founded in 1952. This work was compiled from his memory and old photographs and every effort was made to include everyone but due to the fact it was over sixty years ago some people may have been left out but not forgotten. We will correct this in time. The first committee of Rahan Comhaltas included Joe Minnock from Cappaloughan, Joe Cusack of Tully and Jimmy Minnock of The Island. The first music Teachers at Rahan Comhaltas were the great Dan Cleary, Mick Boland and Sean Grennan. They thought music to the first students of Rahan Comhaltas which included the following: Joe O Brien, Mick Lynam, Liam Rigney, Dave Waters, Danny Feighery, Nancy Monaghan, Marie Grennan, Sean Monaghan, Carthage Kidney, Eric Mitchell, Jackie Thomas, Pat Cunningham, Tom Nolan. There were also other musicians in the Rahan area at that time who had influence on the Music but who were not members of Rahan Comhaltas and they were: Billy Healion, Jack Scott, Molly Carroll, Mir Finnerty, Brendan Grennan and Jack Foran. Rahan Comhaltas started in 1952 and was also the catalyst for the creation of the Ballinamere Céilí Band during the 1950s which consisted of the following musicians: Dan Cleary (Fiddle), Joe Weir(Fiddle), Mick Mullins (Accordian) Mick Boland, Sean Grennan, Des Coughlan (Banjo), P.J. Pender (Drums), Leon Ronson (Piano), Peter Kilroe (Flute and Saxaphone) and Joe Hennessey (vocals). This simple historical exercise was done to document the starting point of Rahan Comhaltas for the purposes of compiling a more detailed historical documentation of that time. We would appreciate any feedback or details which might be used to either correct any errors or add detail to the outline above. It is hoped over time to develop a better historical picture of our organisation and you can help.
